What is the Weekend to End Women's Cancers?

- The annual Weekend to End Women's Cancers is a two-day 60km walk, or a one-day 30km walk, bringing together thousands of women and men in support of the fight against women's cancers.
- 1 in 7 Canadian women will be diagnosed with breast or gynecologic cancers in their lifetime.
- To date, a total of over \$123 million has been raised enabling numerous advances in cancer research and care. Monies continue to fund critical research, clinical enhancements and survivorship programs for breast and gynecological cancers at the Princess Margaret
- The 2012 edition of The Weekend walk begins early Saturday, September 8th. Walkers then head out and cover approximately 30kms making their way to camp, where a warm meal and entertainment is provided. The two 60 km journey ends Sunday afternoon, September 9th.
- Throughout the weekend, walkers are supported by hundreds of Volunteers and Crew Members who provide meals, water, snack stops and comprehensive medical services, as well as ensure gear transport, and safety on the streets.
